Use this planning chart as a handy cheat sheet when organizing asks to key local, state, and national decision makers for the Week Without Driving

The Improvement	Decision Maker	Participation and Improvement Ask	Follow Up
What policy or improvement are you seeking to advance/win?	Who is the decision maker and what direct authority do they have related to the improvement being sought?	What activity are they participating in, and what is the direct ask that will highlight the improvement ask you are seeking?	How will the improvement ask be solidified?
Example: Increased funding for Transit Operations by supporting the Stronger Communities Through Better Transit Act.	Rep. Doris Matsui	Will participate in a ride along with an organizational member and will be asked to sign onto the Stronger Communities Through Better Transit Act.	Will write an email update that will be posted on Congressperson's website highlighting their experience on the ride along and announcing their co-sponsorship of the bill
